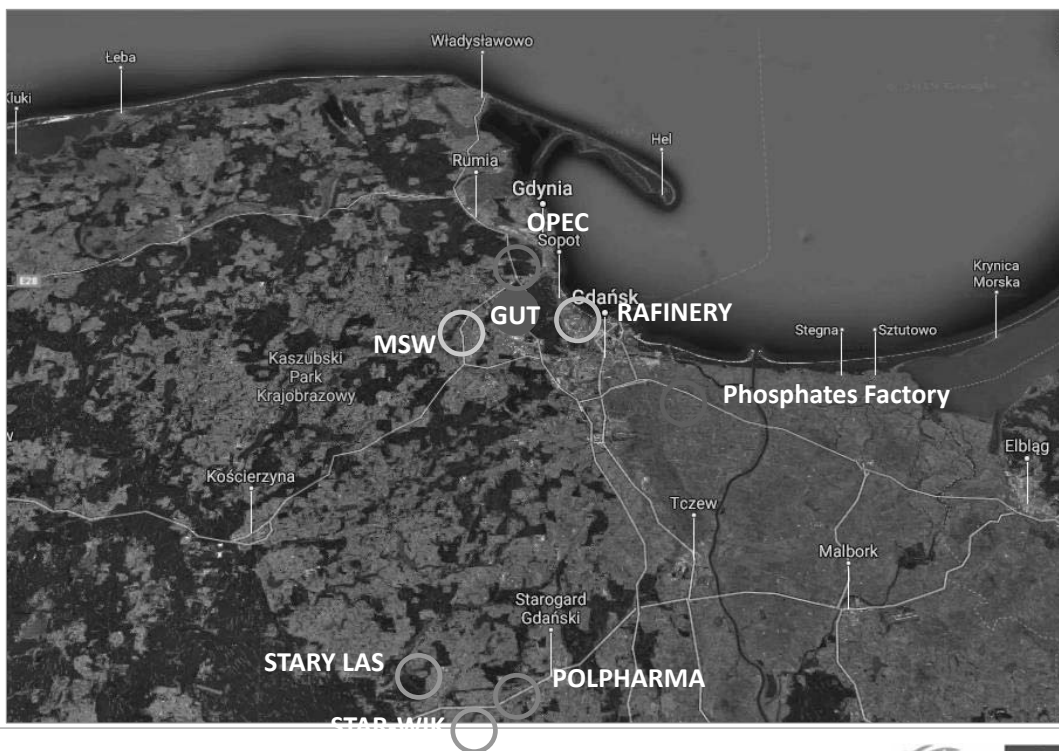

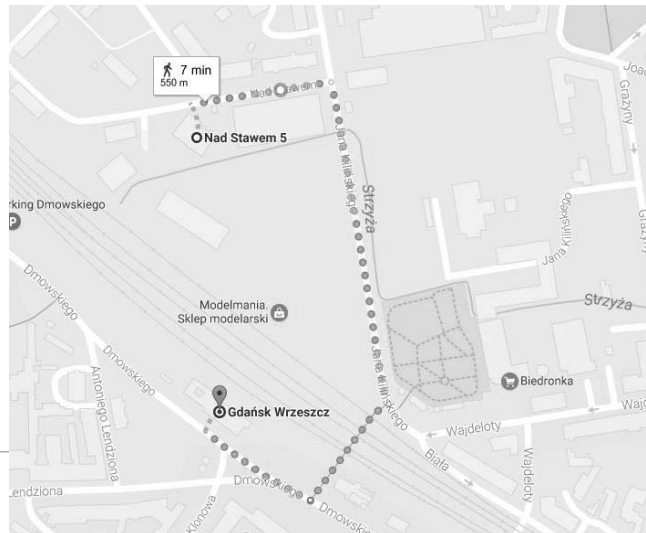

Practical Information

Hotels

Please consider **Focus Hotel Premium**, located in Gdańsk Wrzeszcz (**str. Nad Stawem 5, 80-454 Gdańsk**), approximately 7 minutes walking distance from the Gdańsk Wrzeszcz railway station (direct train to the airport), which has a good price.



1. Travel from the Gdańsk airport

The Lech Walesa Airport is your destination. There are several options to get to the hotel from the airport:

Travelling by train (most recommended)

- There is a direct train connection between the airport and the Gdańsk Wrzeszcz (Railway Station), which takes about 25 minutes. It is a walking distance from the station to the hotel (about 7 minutes).
- **Travelling by taxi**
 - Taxis are available at the airport.
- **Travelling by bus**
 - A regular bus connection between the airport and Gdańsk Wrzeszcz is available from the arrival terminal (approx. 30 minutes), line 110 (Port Lotniczy-Wrzeszcz PKP).
